- 1:1-11 Luke recounts the Ascension event of Jesus and the 11 apostles.
- 1:12-14 The Apostles and disciples gather in Jerusalem.
- 1:15-20 Peter recognizes Judas' choice as a fulfilled prophecy.
- 1:21-26 Matthias is selected to replace Judas according to God's will.

Chapter 2

- 2:1-13 The 12 are filled with the Spirit and speak in other languages.
- 2:14-21 The Apostles proclaim prophecy has announced these days.
- 2:22-36 Christ is taught and proven with 4 lines of evidence.
- 2:37-41 3,000 people are baptized as the church begins on Pentecost.
- 2:42-47 By the Apostles' works, the church was growing rapidly.

Chapter 3

3:1-10 – Peter and John are at the temple. Peter heals the lame man.

3:11-26 – Peter preaches a second sermon about the glory of Jesus

Chapter 4

4:1-12 – Peter and John are detained but speak with inspired boldness.

4:23-31 – They gathered with brethren to pray and be encouraged.

4:32-37 – The congregation shared generously with one another.

Chapter 5

5:1-11 – Peter must deal with the deception of Ananias and Sapphira.

5:12-16 – The Apostles' miracles continue to lead people to Christ.

5:17-26 – They Apostles are arrested but freed by an angel of the Lord.

5:27-32 – Peter and the Apostles proclaimed obedience to God over all.

5:33-42 – The High Priest and Council choose to flog and release the 12.

- **Ch. 1** The Apostles OBEY and ORGANIZE.
- **Ch. 2** The Apostles receive POWER and PREACH.
- Ch. 3 Two Apostles continue with POWER and PREACHING.

Chapter 6

- 7:1-50 Stephen's Defense: God was with Israel for 1,000 years!
 v.24-43 But Israel often opposed God and His chosen ones.
- 7:51-60 Stephen's Defense: The Jews are repeating their sins! v.54-60 Stephen, with Christ-like faith, is martyred.

Chapter 8

- 8:1-4 A great persecution caused Christian Jews to flee Jerusalem.
- 8:5-13 Philip preaches in Samaria, converting even Simon.
- 8:14-25 Peter and John travel to Samaria to share Spiritual Gifts.
 - -- Simon's greed puts his soul in Jeopardy.
- 8:26-40 Philip preaches Jesus to Candace and she is baptized.

Chapter 9

9:32-40 – Peter heals one and raises another in the Joppa region.

The 1st Gentile Convert - The Events Demand 3 Conclusions

- v. 25-29 No man is unholy or unclean (unfit for the Gospel)
- v. 34-35 Any man who fears and obeys is welcome to God
- v. 47-48 No one can refuse such a one from baptism into Christ!

Chapter 11

- v.1-3 Peter returns to Jerusalem and is questioned by Jews
- v.4-16 Peter recounts all four miracles God worked
- v.17-18 Peter restates the conclusion and the brethren agree
 - v.19-26 Barnabas and Paul help the Antioch church grow.
 - v.27-30 Antioch sends funds to Jerusalem to help brethren

Chapter 11:17-18

God gave them the same gift as He gave to us after believing in the Lord Jesus Christ

Well then, God has granted to the Gentiles also the repentance that leads to life.

Chapter 12

- v.1-5 Herod kills James and detains Peter with intent to kill him also.
- v.5-10 An angel delivers Peter from jail. (Acts 5:19)
- v.11-17 Peter went to Mary's home and told them what happened.
- v.18-23 Herod is frustrated and is eventually killed by an angel.
- v.24-25 The church continues to grow. Paul/Barnabas return to Antioch.
